



Jeanne & Peter Lougheed Performing Arts Centre - Camrose, Alberta

A unique performing arts venue, the Jeanne and Peter Lougheed Performing Arts Centre is located on the University of Alberta's Augustana Campus in Camrose Alberta.

"The overall design for the building included a great deal of attention not only to what the community was envisioning for the space but also towards sustainability for the future. The theatre is home to the largest integrated photovoltaic array, (solar panels), which blanket the entire 70' fly-tower, including the North face, and is (was) the first theatre in North America to use entirely LED lighting, including the stage lights, on the interior and exterior of the building."

Allstar was contracted to supply and install the sound, communication, paging and video systems in the Centres Cargill Theatre and lobby.

The main components of the sound system are powered Meyer Sound UPQ, UPA, UPM and 600HP speakers controlled with a Galileo 408 processor. At front of house is a DiGiCo Sd9 surface with two D-racks. Communications are Clear-Com and video is a 10,000 lumen Panasonic PT-DZ10K projector with shutter, 15'x24' screen and Crestron DMPS-300-C switcher which is able to take DMX from the house lighting console to control the projectors shutter for true house to black.
